On day two, the participants were hosted in 311Verona, one of the most prominent and innovative coworking spaces, sited next to the city centre of Verona.

The students were divided into groups and involved in laboratories focused on green and tech innovation. In the afternoon, each group presented the morning experience, results, reflections, ideas, impressions with the aim of capitalising the experience. At the end of the day, each student exchanged impressions, emotions and ideas with the peers.



















Day 3 - 23rd November

On day three, the participants were hosted in t2i incubator in Rovigo, where several innovative startups are incubated and accelerated and where ten out of them are physically allocated. In the morning, the students discovered the activities of the incubator and visited the FabLab PopLabspace, which is divided into four work areas: Digital, Manufacturing, Electronics and Construction. of good practices





In the afternoon they enjoyed an experiential training, building towers with marshmallows and spagnetti, that was aimed at developing some soft skills such as teamwork, time management and leadership.
